What did people apply for?

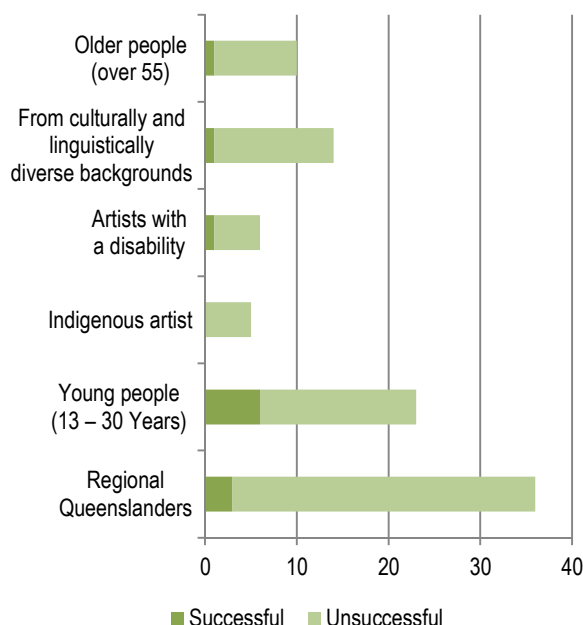
Music (38%) and visual arts, craft and design (35%) were the art forms with the highest number of applications.

Visual arts, craft and design had the highest number of successful applicants (6), followed by theatre (3), music (2) and writing (2). The high success rate of visual arts applications in this round was due to a proportion of the Individuals Fund budget coming from the Visual Arts and Craft Strategy which is a Federal Government partnership with Arts Queensland.

Community engagement and multi-arts received no funding in this round.

Who applied?

People can identify with one or more of the following groups. For example, someone can identify as a young person and a regional Queenslander.



Where were the proposed activities?

Applicants list the location of proposed activities and are able to include more than one place, for example, presenting work at international arts markets in the USA and Brisbane.

20 successful



Activities in Australia, outside Queensland

6 proposed

3 successful



Activities in Queensland

58 proposed

3 successful

How much?

\$651 229 was requested from the Individuals Fund by 85 people.

\$62 868 was invested in 14 artists.

Successful applicants received an average of 62% of their initial funding request.
